Your CRP contract provides benefits in exchange for installing and maintaining conservation practices on agricultural land. Conservation practices must be installed and maintained according to your conservation plan along with specific CRP program requirements. The following information is in addition to your conservation plan and provides specific CRP program policy requirements. Not following these requirements could put your CRP contract in jeopardy.

Communication is important. Please contact a conservation planner at your local field office if you have questions about your conservation plan.



Iowa CRP Primary Nesting Season:

May 15 – August 1

Conservation Practice Installation

- Your conservation plan and associated *Implementation Requirements (IR)* sheets provide information and design for installing and maintaining the conservation practices.
- Conservation practices must be installed as scheduled in the conservation plan.
- Conservation practices must be installed in the first 12 months of the contract. FSA may grant extensions beyond 12 months if supported by the conservation plan, or due to circumstances outside of your control.
- Conservation practices must be installed according to NRCS conservation practice standards. Your seeding plan and any other needed practice designs are included in your conservation plan, install all practices according to the design.

Conservation Practice Establishment

- Conduct practice establishment activities such as mowing according to your conservation plan and supplemental information. Reference the *Iowa Native Prairie Planting Guide* included with your conservation plan for detailed establishment information.
- Starting in contract year 3, establishment activities such as mowing, spraying, or burning will not be allowed during the primary nesting season, May 15 – August 1, unless permission is granted by the FSA County Committee.

Conservation Practice Maintenance

- Approved cover type according to the CRP contract must be maintained for the length of the contract period.
- Maintain your conservation practices for the life of the CRP contract.
- Unauthorized haying and grazing is prohibited. Haying and grazing is only authorized with prior approval from FSA. Your conservation plan must be updated if authorized for haying and grazing. Reduced annual rental payment and other restrictions apply.
- Widespread mowing for cosmetic purposes is not allowed at any time.
- Control weeds including invasive, noxious or prohibited plants, including such maintenance as necessary to avoid the spread of weeds to surrounding land. Treatment methods will comply with all local, state and federal laws and ordinances.
- Volunteer trees not allowed. Control volunteer trees when they are small to avoid costly removal of large trees.
- After the establishment period spot mowing, burning, hand pulling, or spot herbicide treatment shall be used to control weeds and other undesirable plant growth.
- After establishment maintenance activities such as mowing, spraying or burning will not be allowed during Iowa's primary nesting season, May 15 – August 1.
- Annual mowing of CRP for generic weed control is not allowed at any time after establishment.
- Reseeding may be required in order to maintain the approved cover.
- Herbicide and insecticide application in adjacent cropland must be controlled to not drift into CRP acres. Reseed appropriately if cover is damaged by herbicide drift. Protect beneficial insects by controlling insecticide drift.
- CRP acres may not be used as a permanent travel lane or road. You may drive equipment on CRP acres for maintenance purposes but must not create travel lanes.

Required Management Activity

- Certain CRP practices require management activity once during the contract period.
- Required management activities must be performed according to the schedule in the conservation plan and no later than 3 years prior to the contract expiration date.
- If management is required, it will be included as Early Successional Habitat Management (647) in your conservation plan.
- If management is required, then reference the Mid Contract Management job sheet.
