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Project Timeline

The District Trustees, requested Clapsaddle-Garber Associates to investigate and report concerning repairs to the upper Main Tile of Drainage District No. 3. As a result, Clapsaddle-Garber Associates generated an Engineer's Report dated May 17, 2021, summarizing past improvements and repairs, investigating the necessity and feasibility of repairs/improvements to the upper Main Tile in Drainage District No. 3 and presenting opinions of construction costs associated with said repairs/improvements. The Engineer's Report was presented to the District Trustees and a hearing concerning said report was conducted on August 16, 2021. As a result, a Supplement Engineer's Report was produced dated September 3, 2021 and a continuation of the public hearing was held on September 13, 2021. As a result, the Trustees authorized Clapsaddle-Garber Associates to proceed with completion of project plans and specifications for the repair/improvements option presented in said report and proceed with a bid letting.

Clapsaddle-Garber Associates completed the authorized plans and specifications and a bid letting date of March 7, 2022 was set. The project was advertised, and bids were received from qualified contractors. The following bids for said repairs to this district for the RCP option were received:

The District Trustees identified Hands on Excavating LLC as the lowest responsible bidder for the project and awarded the project to them. The contract was signed on March 3, 2022. Construction activities were started during the week of July 4, 2022. During the construction period, conditions were favorable for construction other than the occasional weather related delays. Pipe installation / final grading was completed the week of December 5, 2022 (the week after the contract completion date). However, completion of punchlist items was not achieved until the week of January 8, 2024.

Project Deviations

This project followed the authorized plans and specifications well, with the following deviations (for reference see as-built plan sheets included in Appendix V):

 During construction, it was found that the quantities needed for several items including pipe, fittings, private tile connections, etc were different than those anticipated in the bid quantities for the project. This resulted in a decrease of \$14,755.36 and no change to the substantial completion date.

Final Project Costs

The final project costs for construction (for reference see the final pay estimate included in Appendix W) and engineering (not including reports) are estimated at \$506,166.10, which is approximately \$26,400.00 more than those presented at the hearing. These costs may vary depending upon any damage claims brought forth at the completion hearing. Pending no claims, the costs are as detailed below:

The total project cost is above those opinions of cost contained within said Engineer's Report, but the contractor's total work completion period was slower than anticipated and bid prices were higher than anticipated due to supply chain issues. It should be noted that the above costs do not include any administrative costs, legal costs, interest on construction warrants, or damage claims.

Damages


During construction, crop damage was incurred by two property owners on this project. Impacted acres consisted of corn and bean production being grown in the vicinity of the repair. Some unfarmed ground (cover was grass) was disturbed for the construction of the repair, but since it was not under production this has not been tabulated. The following table shows the property owner impacted, which type of crops were impacted, and the number of acres damaged:




It is our recommendation that landowners or their tenants be paid for damage claims consistent with the above if they choose to file them. It should also be noted that in addition to the above, there may be additional landowners or tenants who were unable to plant a crop due to construction and may be entitled to crop damage claims. It is our recommendation that those claims (if filed) be evaluated individually.


Pending Items

As of the writing of this report, this project is complete (including punch list items) in general accordance with the authorized plans and specifications. Additionally, lien waivers for suppliers have been submitted by the general contractor (for reference see Appendix X). After the completion hearing, final payment of \$40,916.61 needs to be authorized by the Trustees and the applicable highway authorities should be invoiced for the applicable cost of road crossings (assumed to be Items R1-R11) highlighted pink on the final pay estimate. It is our recommendation that the project be accepted. We also recommend that the entire project be walked and reviewed just prior to the expiration of the contract warranty period for any warranty items that may need to be remedied by the contractor. It should be noted that if the Trustees decide to have Clapsaddle-Garber Associates exercise this recommendation, there are no engineering fees included in the above Final Project Costs to cover this service. Also, it should be noted that the metal grating cover at the start of the project was a custom constructed item and it is not clear at this point what the functionality or lifespan of the same is. So, its condition and functionality should also be monitored.
